

Pension Application for Simeon Wylie

On this twenty third day of September 1818 before the subscriber one of the Associate Judges fro said county personally appears Simeon Wylie aged sixty year resident of Great Bend Township in said County who being by me first duly sworn according to law doth on his solemn oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provisions made by the late act of Congress entitled and [an] act making provision for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War that the said Simeon Wylie enlisted some time in May 1778 at Albany in the State of New York for nine months in the company commanded by Capt Peltons and the Regt of Col VanCourtland in the New York line which company was afterwards commanded by Capt Fraench [French] in the same Regt and that he continued to serve in the same corps in the service of the United States untill some time in the month of March 1779 when he was discharged from service at Mombankus called Rochester in the State of New York and that he was in the Battle of Monmouth and that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of assistance from his country for his support and that he has no other evidence now in his power than is herewith presented—of his said services.
