Sir,

In behalf of a very worthy Widow, and to the end, that she may be benefitted thereby, I take the liberty of requesting from you the information, if the name of "Samuel Young" be on the Rolls of the Revolutionary Army. Said Young was one of the Staff Officers in the Regiment under Gen'l McDougal at "Fort McDougal" near "fort Swift" on Long Island N.Y. in 1776 from whence they retreated & joined the forces at the battle of White Plains.
